Internship Opportunities

The following internship opportunities can fit into day, evening or week-end schedules. AFN will work with students to obtain college credit.

International Young Eco-Hero Award Assistant

Assist the Project Coordinator with responding to the applications and with the selection process. Liaison with young award winners to set up individual certificate ceremonies and publicity; assist with publicity and outreach, as well as administration of the award program.

Media coordination

Assist in writing press releases and obtaining individual coverage for Eco-Hero award winners.

National School Recycling Program

Assist with designing a national school recycling program. Components will consist of a youth advisory board, outreach to students, and program design.

Blog administration

Assist with monitoring Action For Nature's youth blog and recruitment of new members

Book self-publishing and search for new sales

Coordination of the self-publishing of our book "Acting For Nature." Search for new orders so that we can increase our revenue stream.
