

Campus-wide Transportation Survey – Student Workers Needed

SF State will conduct an on-campus transportation survey on **April 27, 2011**. The survey will provide important information to the University in regards to how people get to and from campus on a typical day. The survey will be conducted through a cordon count, as described below, followed by an on-line survey:

Cordon Count Survey: A cordon count survey will be conducted between 6:30am and 7:30pm on April 27th. Sixteen locations have been identified as cordon count locations around the campus. The locations will be used to count the number of people commuting to and from campus by driving alone, carpool, vanpool, motorbike, bicycle and walking.

There will be two cordon count shifts: 6:30am to 12:30 pm and 12:30pm to 7:30pm. However the same person could work both shifts if they want. There will be a need for at least 21 surveyors for each shift (including some break relievers) and more if some surveyors do not work a full 12-hour shift. In addition, all surveyors will need to attend a training session on Monday, April 25, 5:30-6:30 PM, in HUM 587. **All surveyors will be paid \$17/hour**, including the training.
