The Western Divide is located on the western slope of the southern Sierra Nevada mountain range with elevations from 1,000 to 10,000+ feet. It encompasses the southern portion of the Giant Sequoia National Monument and a portion of the Golden Trout wilderness. The Giant Sequoia National Monument has 33 groves of giant sequoia. The area enjoys a mild, dry climate with an average high of 75 degrees in summer and 42 degrees in winter. Winter snowfall averages six to ten feet, with over 30 feet at 10,000+ foot elevation. The area enjoys over 300 days of sunshine.
