

Web Announcement for Employers & Organizations

Employers: If you are looking for a student intern, employee, or volunteer for your organization you can send an announcement to the Environmental Studies Program (envs@sfsu.edu) and we will share it with our 290 plus majors. We offer five degrees ranging from BA's in Humanities and the Environment, or Environmental Sustainability and Social Justice, to BS degrees in Earth Systems Science or Natural Resource Management and Conservation – so we have students with a broad range of interests and skills.

Our students are required to do an internship as part of their Environmental Studies major - so we always have a number of students looking for internships. They are required to do a minimum of 80 hours in their internships, but many students do much more than that. And some students may be looking for shorter internships, which will give them experience even if they don't meet our internship requirement. Students tend to do fall semester (End of August through mid December), spring semester (February through mid-May) or summer internships (Mid-May through end of August). The best time to let students know about internship opportunities is 4-6 weeks before the start of each internship period - so mid July for Fall internships, early Jan for spring internships, and early April for summer internships. There may be students available to do internships outside these time periods.

A job, internship, or volunteer announcement should have contact information, tell students how to apply and what the time frame is for applications, any information about schedule if there is something fixed ahead of time (e.g. must be able to work Wednesday evenings), explain at least briefly what type of work it is, and for internships, whether it is paid or not.
