

You can do your actual internship during the summer and take the internship course, ENVS 680, the following fall. However, you need to do three homework assignments for the internship course during the summer:

1. You must get a signed work agreement from your supervisor. The work agreement template is available as a word document on the envs 680 page.
2. If your internship ends during the summer you should have your supervisor complete an evaluation of your work. You can get the supervisor evaluation word document on the envs 680 page. Have your supervisor send the evaluation to Carlos Davidson at carlosd@sfsu.edu.
3. You must keep a log/journal – ultimately a total of 9 pages, single spaced, total length. The details of the log/journal assignment are in the assignments file available on the ENVS 680 page.
